NSBA rule 84 – Color : A color horse is one who is registered with IBHA, PHBA, PTHA, ABRA, ApHC, APHA, POA.

A solid bred/breeding stock is considered a color horse only if the sire or dam has regular registry papers with one or more of the following associations: APHA, ApHC, ABRA, IBHA, PHBA and POA. PTHA solid registered is not considered a color horse unless it is also registered with one or more of the aforementioned breed associations

NSBA rule 213 – Walk/Trot Classes: Only one horse/rider combination is allowed per class. If an exhibitor enters into a

Non-Pro Walk Trot class that exhibitor could not show in a loping/cantering class at that same show. However, that exhibitor can switch back and forth between the different shows (ex.: APHC)

Merger of classes : Junior and Senior Open Classes, if there are less than 3 entries in one of the classes, they will be held together as all aged classes.

Same principle will apply for longline and trail in hand classes

APHA & NSBA classes and potentially, APHC classes, will be held class in class, except for the open Western Pleasure and Hunter Under Saddle if a rider is entered in these classes with different horses..

The 5 following classes will be run twice (same pattern).

- Showmanship
- In-Hand Trail
- Trail (all trail classes)
- Western Horsemanship
- Hunt seat equitation

The first run will be judged by judges 1&2 and the second run will be judged by judges 3&4.

You must not lunge or ride on the showground without a valid entry number. The whole facility, especially the warm-up pen will be checked on unsportsmanlike behavior (Rulebook VIO200).

Longeing is only allowed at the indicated places.

Two highly sought after talents of an all-around horse are the ability to change leads and navigate trail poles. Blend these four components into an event and you have the Pleasure Versatility Challenge. The event will highlight a well-conformed, athletic western pleasure horse, with a solid base of proper training, that has the potential to transition and become high level-caliber in a number of classes – eventually reaching the level of the highest performing all-around horses.

The same concept will apply for the Ranch Versatility Challenge.

A 3-year-old can be shown in the longe line class **or** in the saddle classes and CANNOT be shown in both categories.

ELIGIBILITY AND RULES

Registration forms to participate to the EAF Futurity and Maturity classes **MUST** be submitted to the show secretary by **1 September at the latest. No exception to this deadline will be made.**

RULES AND REGULATIONS

GOVERNING REGULATION

The European Appaloosa Championship (EAC) shall be governed by the rules and regulations of the ApHC Official Rulebook.

The NSBA International Championship shall be governed by the rules and regulations of the NSBA Official Rulebook.

All participants and horse owners agree to abide by such rules and regulations.

ELIGIBILITY TO THE EUROPEAN APPALOOSA CHAMPIONSHIP TITLES

To participate to the EAC, the owner of the horse at least must be resident in a European State. For the purpose of this regulations Europe is intended in its enlarged geographical meaning.

The exhibitor and the horse owner must be affiliates of a member of the European Appaloosa Foundation (ex. ApHCF, ApHC Germany, ...). If the country of residency does not offer such an association of their choice, the exhibitor and the horse owner must become affiliate of another member of the European Appaloosa Foundation.

Each participant will be personally responsible for the residency statements provided to the EC organization on the entry forms. Copy of the membership card to an EAF affiliate must be attached to the entry form.

ELIGIBILITY TO THE NSBA INTERNATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP TITLES

Horses and exhibitors must be duly registered with the NSBA. No other eligibility or qualification requirements. <https://www.nsba.com/european-horse-registration>

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Each horse must be liability insured, free of any epidemic disease and must come from a stable free of any epidemical disease. The horse must be as well vaccinated against influenza. The certificate of vaccination must accompany the horse and it must be produced at the show office upon request.

The equine passport must be presented at the registration registration office upon arrival. For foreign horses also a current TRACES. The vaccination regulations of the EWU Germany apply.

INSURANCE AND OTHER REGULATIONS



Every horse must have liability insurance. Each horse owner at assignment of entry, each companion and visitor when entering the show area agrees with the directives and instructions of the organizer and agrees to the regulations of the ApHC or NSBA.

Participation and attendance at the show is entirely at your own risk. Neither the EAF organization nor the organization nor the location accepts any liability for loss, damage or theft of your horse(s) and/or property, nor for any injury suffered or death of a participating and/or present horse, rider or visitor during the entire duration of the show/event.

OFFICIAL RULEBOOK AND CONDITIONS OF THE ANNOUNCEMENT.

The organizer is entitled to modify the competition according to the ApHC and NSBA Official Rulebook, to reschedule the show or, upon repaying the fees, to cancel the show if deemed necessary under special circumstances. There is no contractual relationship between the promoter on the one hand and the visitors, competitors, exhibitors, and owners on the other hand. Liability for theft and injury of persons or animals is excluded. Each horse owner and participant submit with depositing the entry form and each escort and visitor submits by entering the show ground, to the guidance of the promoter as well as to the rules and regulations of the ApHC and NSBA.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

Entries will only be processed if:

- The entry forms are filled out correctly and have been submitted online (cfr. the relevant link) in time for the entry deadline.
- The entry and stable fees are paid and credited to the relevant account until three days after receiving the confirmation.
- A copy of the ApHC/APHA Certificate of Registration is enclosed (except for NSBA classes) and/or, for NSBA classes, a copy of the NSBA Registration papers.
- A copy of the current ApHC/NSBA/APHA membership of the exhibitor/rider (Open, Amateur or Youth) is enclosed. New membership cards can also be purchased at the show office.
- Germany requires that, all foreign horses travel with a health certificate (TRACES). Foreign horses without health certificates may not be brought to Germany. The vet papers will be checked locally by the official veterinarian. By sending the entry, the competitor/exhibitor agrees to comply with the

rules and regulations as stated in the show announcement, including the hygiene concept. The promoter is not responsible for late or lost entry forms. The competitor has the sole responsibility for his start.

REFUNDS

Except in case of lockdown due to Covid-19, registration can be cancelled but without refunds. Presenting a vet certificate before the beginning of a show the show management allow the repayment of half of the entry fee. Office charge on principle will not be repaid. Fee for stalls is only repaid if the reserved stall is rentable again.

ON-SITE CHECK-IN INFORMATION

Upon entry, every exhibitor and owner and all other participants accept the facility and grounds, including, but not limited to, the arena, stalls and where the show is being conducted on an “as is” basis and agree to be solely responsible for property damage or personal injury caused by third parties to the exhibitor, participant or owner, his/her property or staff, or caused by himself/herself, his/her participant horses, exhibitors, representatives, agents and employees occurring in conjunction with this show; and further agree to indemnify and hold the EAF harmless from any and all such liability, whenever or however, arising, not caused by EAF’s own negligence or that of EAF’s representatives, agents or employees.

CLIPPING AND EQUIPMENT

Applicable rules are those of the hosting country.

TITLES, PLACING AND TIE PROCEDURES

EUROPEAN & INTERNATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP TITLES

The titles of APHC European Champion and NSBA International Champion will be awarded only if there are at least 3 starters in the relevant class.

APHA shows are not championships.

PLACED CLASSES

In placed classes, medals and Champion and reserve Champion titles will award the horse/exhibitor earning the highest number of points, accounted as follows:

1. Place = 120 Points
2. Place = 105 Points
3. Place = 91 Points
4. Place = 78 Points
5. Place = 66 Points
6. Place = 55 Points
7. Place = 45 Points



8. Place = 36 Points
9. Place = 28 Points
10. Place = 21 Points
11. Place = 15 Points
12. Place = 10 Points
13. Place = 6 Points
14. Place = 3 Points
15. Place = 1 Point

The ties in non-scored classes will be broken through a tie judge. The tie-judge will be defined everyday by the show management and published to the exhibitors.

SCORED CLASSES

If there is a tie for the three first places, the tie will be worked off until there is a winner. All other ties will be broken through tie-breaker judges.

Judge number 1 is the first tiebreaker. If judge number 1 scored the tied horses alike, then judge number 2 becomes the tiebreaker. If judge number 2 scored the tied horses alike, then judge number 3 becomes the tiebreaker.

The order of the tie-judges will be defined by the show management and published to the exhibitors. In case the tie cannot be broken by any tie-break judge the tie will remain unbroken.

ALL-AROUND CHAMPION

In the Youth, Non-Pro and Open Classes, the All-Around Champions will be awarded. Only APHC or NSBA approved classes will count.

PATTERNS

Patterns will be available in the Show Office. One week prior to the show all patterns will also be made available for downloading on www.europeanappaloosa.com

MEDIA RULE

With the submission of the entry form, the participant accepts to be photographed and/or filmed at the event and gives the consent for publishing of the pictures or footage. In addition, preparation areas and show arenas are possibly video-monitored Photographers and videographers commissioned by the Show Management have exclusive rights. No other photographer or videographer is allowed to offer pictures of the event for sale. Private photographing is solely allowed outside the arena.

DOGS

On the show grounds, dogs must be kept at a leash. Loose dogs will be captured and can be redeemed at the Show Office for a 100 Euros fee. Who gets

caught not cleaning up after his dog must pay a 50 Euros fine.

STALL DECORATION

Any fabric or paper used or draped in stalls must be fire-resistant or treated with a flame retardant. The following may NOT be used: nails, liquid nails, bolts, screws, rubber cement, etc. Any damage to stalls will be the financial responsibility of the owner/exhibitor/trainer.

3 YEARS OLD HORSES CLASSES

A 3-year-old can be shown in long line classes and trail in hand classes or in saddle classes but CANNOT be shown in both categories (In Hand & Under the saddle).

Hunter in Hand classes and Halter classes are not concerned by this restriction.

DOPING CONTROLS

The EAF and the show manager, may arbitrarily choose classes and within them the places to be tested. The testing procedure will be determined by the EAF. By submitting the entry form riders, exhibitors and horse owners agree to their horses being drug tested (blood or urine). Tests will be performed in accordance with the current NSBA list of prohibited substances (prohibited substances list in the NSBA rulebook). The EAF decides per individual case if a medication will be accepted (medication sheet). In case of violations horse owners, riders and horses will be disqualified from the entire event. Paid entries and stable fees will not be refunded. The horse owner/participant agrees to bear the entire costs of the doping test in case of a positive result and to give back any potential titles, awards and prize money as well as to accept all consequences and sanctions imposed by the EAF (bans, fines, etc.).
